

Information on Scales Matter.

Scales Matter is a full band method created by Kevin Hume to help systematically teach the scales from the Arkansas Junior High All Region Scale Sheet.

This is a full length sample copy of the clarinet packet for your perusal.

The exercises, scales, and page numbers all line up from packet to packet so you can use this resource in both individual instrument classes and full band.

All transposing instruments have the concert pitch for each scale labeled at the beginning of each line as well as the written pitches.

The packet begins with some of the first notes you learn on each instrument and builds to one octave scales for every scale in the Arkansas Junior High All Region Scale List.

When I print this file with the default “Preview” app on my computer (Mac), for some reason the fingering diagrams print as a black box instead of the picture, but when I print from a legitimate pdf program it works. (In my case, PDF Element 7.) If you’re having the same issue, I found this workaround online.

For Windows

- Make sure you are using the latest version of [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) – rather than a standard preview application or a web browser. Check Adobe reader for recent updates.
- If you already have the updated version of Adobe Acrobat Reader, open the resource using Adobe and do the following:
 - Choose File → Print
 - Click on Advanced
 - Check the “Print as Image” box and click OK.
 - Click the Print button

For Mac

- Make sure you are using the latest version of [Adobe Acrobat Reader](#) – not “Preview”. Check adobe for recent updates.
- If you already have the updated version of Adobe Acrobat Reader, open the resource using Adobe and do the following:
 - Choose File → Hold it down and press Command.
 - Tell the File to Open in Adobe.
 - Print as normal.

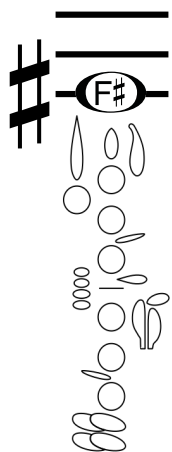

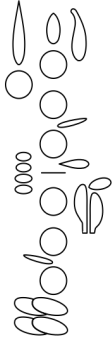

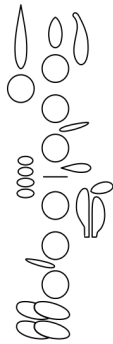

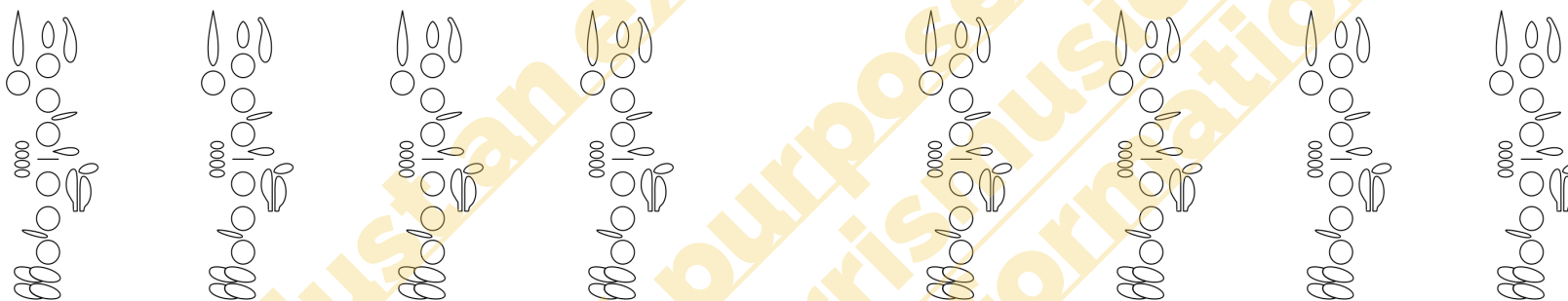

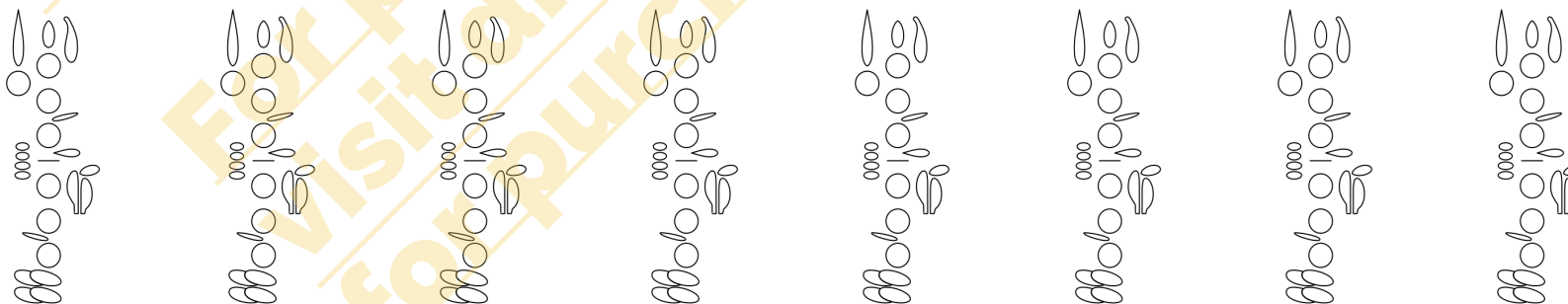
